Have a Question?

Q: How will the stadium be paid for?

Tulane is raising private donations to cover the costs of the stadium project. The university is looking at financing options to cover the cash flow on the project during construction.

Q: Will Tulane need to rent the stadium to pay for its upkeep and maintenance?

No. Ticket sales and sponsorships from the Tulane football program will be sufficient to pay for the stadium's operations, upkeep and maintenance.

Q: Why not renovate Tad Gormley stadium and play football there?

The Green Wave wants to come home to where it played before 1975. The commute to the Superdome has deterred students from attending and Tad Gormley is even farther than the Dome. An on-campus location will provide a more memorable game day experience for our students. Also, the new stadium will enable our neighbors and fans to enjoy Tulane games in a traditional collegiate atmosphere.
