

National transportation experts SP Gameday and parking experts Urban Systems unveiled a plan to shuttle fans to and from the new Tulane Stadium. To accommodate a capacity crowd of 30,000, the companies estimate that approximately 9,100 fans will either walk to the stadium, take public transit or charter buses, taxis or limousines. Of the remaining 20,900, about 11,500 will park on Tulane's campus or in lots within 1.5 miles. The experts estimate that on average, 2.5 fans will ride in each vehicle, so these 11,500 fans will require about 4,600 parking spaces. The university has 1,769 spaces on campus that will be free on game day; Loyola will provide 450 spaces in one of their garages and 2,400 spaces will be rented from local schools, churches and businesses that are within 1.5 miles of campus.

Gameday estimates that this leaves about 9,400 people who will use the Park and Ride shuttles. Using the conservative average of 2.5 passengers per vehicle, an additional 3,760 off-campus spaces are needed. The university will enter into contracts with lots between 1.5 to 4 miles from the stadium, and shuttle fans from these locations.

This system works. In fact, Gameday successfully uses shuttle systems at larger stadiums in urban settings. At Princeton Stadium, for example, the model fulfills 35 percent of game day parking needs. At Tulane, Gameday will implement the system to accommodate only 23 percent of game day parking.
