An on-campus stadium will offer a better collegiate football experience and give the Green Wave the home field advantage that the Superdome can't provide. It also enhances the student and alumni experience and provides another opportunity for the community to enjoy Tulane's campus.


*How will the stadium benefit New Orleans?* The stadium's fiscal impact for our city is and will be significant. The stadium project has a price tag of \$60 million, with \$50 million paying for the construction of the facility and \$10 million for associated costs, including relocating and rebuilding the tennis courts and track facility.

The project will generate hundreds of architecture, engineering and construction jobs and there will be a need for vendors to provide refreshments, security, trash pick-up and parking and shuttle bus services once the stadium is finished. All of these will generate a huge economic impact for the local community.

We also anticipate increased business on game day along the commercial corridors of Claiborne, Maple and Freret streets.

Finally, Tulane has been a proud New Orleanian for 178 years. Whenever we are able to help our community, we do so readily. We are honored to provide local high schools with the opportunity to play occasional games at the stadium, and look forward to extending that invitation to college or pro teams who might need a practice facility in New Orleans once or twice a year.

We are excited about the future of Tulane Stadium and what it will do for New Orleans. *Tulane Stadium really is coming home!*
